

### Palm Sunday

As you place your blessed palms in your home this weekend, take time to do this as a family.

### Holy Thursday



- Wash each other's feet or hands.
- At the end of the Holy Thursday liturgy, the church sanctuary is stripped of all contents, symbolizing emptiness.
- Strip an area of your home that will remind you of emptiness on Good Friday

### Good Friday



- Place a crucifix in the empty space you created
- Invite each member of your household to reverence the crucifix (hold, kiss, touch, genuflect) before you go to bed tonight.

### Holy Saturday



- Display your family's baptismal candles in your "empty space."
- Visit the grave of a loved one.

### Easter Sunday



End meal prayer by saying:  
"He is risen!  
He is risen indeed!"

## Solar Eclipse Plans

The solar eclipse is on April 8. Local law enforcement anticipates very heavy traffic beginning April 5 through 9, especially on April 8. Local law enforcement and authorities advise to secure property and grounds during this time. To help limit parish liability and provide for the security of our church building, grounds, cemeteries and the safety of our staff, we listened to local guidance and will do the following:

~Access to our parking lots, grounds and cemeteries will be blocked off and/or restricted beginning Friday, April 5 through Monday, April 8. Parking lots will be open for weekend Masses.

~The church will be locked except for Masses.

~Offices are closed on Monday, April 8 (eclipse day). Staff will work from home per their normal work schedules.

~Grounds are closed for camping, overnight stays, or any unauthorized use during this time.

We understand this is not very welcoming. We cannot properly staff or provide proper security during these days. The steps we're taking are in line with law enforcement guidance and actions planned for local businesses, parishes, schools, and other entities.

## Gospel Meditation

### Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

A few months before they married, my twenty-three-year-old sister and her fiancé planned a cross-country road trip to visit his family. My parents told them that they could only go if they slept in separate hotel rooms, offering to foot the bill. It might sound prudish, but my parents wanted the young couple to understand that their approaching unity was close, but not yet. Patience solidifies love.

What could this possibly have to do with Palm Sunday? It's usually overlooked, but the Gospels tell us that, after entering Jerusalem, Jesus **"looked around ... and since it was late, went out to Bethany with the twelve"** (Mk 11:11) for the night. Who cares? Why include this detail? Jews in those days believed that the new Davidic King would one day re-enter and "marry" the city. A new future marked by fidelity would begin for God's people. Israel's God would be in union with His people forever. Without over-sexualizing the metaphor, perhaps Jesus refused to sleep in Jerusalem to remind us of his marital purpose. He was entering Jerusalem as the bridegroom-king. It was almost time, but not yet. Soon he will sleep in Jerusalem in the tomb and then something new will begin: his one body, his Church.

**Lenten challenge:** This Holy Week, I challenge you to keep this image in your mind all the way until Easter Sunday: Jesus is the faithful bridegroom who patiently prepares his bride for their new life together. Go to the Good Friday liturgy and kiss the cross. When you do, let that gesture be the long-awaited "I do" to our faithful God, who always waits for us.
