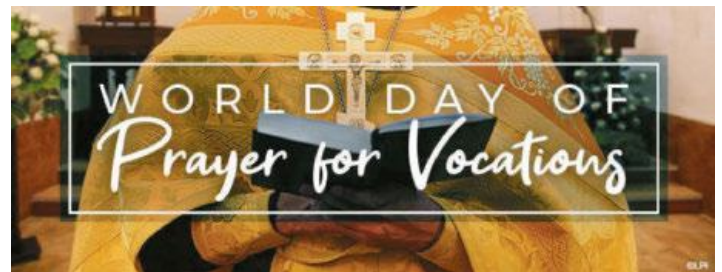

Church Windows – Part 2 by Deacon Greg

Why is it taking so long to fix the window by the Holy Family?

When Bigelow Glass started to refurbish this window, they found the window construction was unstable. This is especially true for the top part of the window (the rosette). Bigelow could not find a way to remove the glass safely without the glass cascading down and breaking the stained glass. We asked Bigelow Glass and Window Creations to look at this window and all of the windows to come up with solution options for us to consider. Both companies provided options and related price quotes.

Over the course of the last half of 2023, we reviewed and considered both companies' options. We visited both companies to view their capabilities and processes. The Finance and Pastoral Councils reviewed and discussed the proposals. While Bigelow Glass does quality work for a lot of parishes, including Tiffin St. Joseph's, they could not come up with a reasonable solution for removing the tops of the windows and did not appear to be able to complete all the windows in a timely manner. Window Creations also has a very good reputation and able to provide us with a solution. They said we could refurbish the stained glass, but it would cost \$1.2 million due to the large percentage of damaged glass and the labor-intensive restoration process. They suggested the use of ultramodern Art Glass at a cost of about \$789,000. We decided to go ahead with this option.

16-Jan-2024 Pastoral-Finance Councils Meeting Minutes

Beginning time: 7:15 PM **Ending Time:** 9:00 PM

Meeting

Broke into groups to pray together and answer the question, “How can I pray for you.”

Parish Survey – Reviewed and discussed the upcoming 2024 parish survey. The survey and fall parish assembly theme is “Listening, Leading, Loving”. The survey is to begin the weekend of March 10th and end on Palm Sunday, March 24th. We will conduct the survey both online and by manual response cards. Results of survey will be shared with parishioners like the 2013 survey and will be the basis for a parish assembly sometime in late summer or in the fall.

Business Manager Position – Steve plans to retire as of 9/30/2024. Council reviewed and discussed the options and timeline for the application, interview and hiring process. The goal is to have the person start on 8/1/2024 if possible.

Church windows – Reviewed and discussed options for the replacement and/or refurbishment of our current church stained-glass windows and replacement of the church’s storm windows. Reviewed options from Bigelow Glass and Window Creations. If we include scenes in the new window design, we may have a committee to help select the window scene options for consideration by parish leadership, Finance and Pastoral Council for presentation to Fr. Tim upon his return.

Parish facilities – We have received about \$60,000 of the expected \$188,000 of Living Christ Campaign funds. The funds are targeted for parish hall classroom renovations. The Council reviewed and discussed how we might continue with these renovations. The National Historic Register designation of the parish hall, rectory and church does not limit us on how we renovate the buildings. It may put restrictions on what we do if we sell the buildings. Discussed these renovations in relation to church renovations and how they all play into our overall need for a capital fundraising campaign.

Received an update on the rectory renovations. Bish Construction is the general contractor for the project with help from Brian and Mary Ann Zoeller.

General concern was expressed about how long we will continue to be a parish, whether it is advisable to make major capital improvements and a related fundraising campaign. Consensus was we cannot live in fear and need to press on.

Discussed parish cemetery memorial options. No decisions made. Concern was expressed about the cost of the memorials and the need to keep the memorials as maintenance free as possible.

Received an update on those attending the One Bread One Cup Youth Leadership Conference June 28 – July 2. Discussed possible fundraising options.

Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

Recently I was with my little dog Libby at a retreat center in the Arizona desert. I sat in a chair near a ravine filled with shrubs. Unbeknownst to me, Libby wandered down there and disappeared. Suddenly an animal's wild shriek erupted from the area. Without thinking, I bolted down into the ravine fully expecting to see coyotes, javelinas, or rattlesnakes. I didn't care. I desperately wanted to get Libby out of there, without any self-regard. Before I could face whatever danger lay hidden, my dog blissfully trotted out from an entirely different area, utterly unaware that I had (quite heroically) just placed my life on the line.

When the adrenaline wore off, I thought to myself: how far would I have been willing to go to save her? I don't know. But I do know, if I had literally died, my friends and family would have certainly thought me insane for dying for a dog. No offense, Libby.

How passionately Jesus wants us to know him and his willingness to die for us! This week he says, "**I know my own and my own know me,**" and "**I lay down my life for the sheep.**" Here we encounter an insanely excessive love for us. Christianity is a relationship and not simply a religion or ethical code. In Jesus, God rescues and saves us. He laid down his life for you and me — and he has taken it up again. So often we are like Libby — blissfully ignorant of the reality of both our spiritual danger and his saving love. This Easter season, the risen Jesus calls us to be more conscious than ever before about his love. He never ceases to lay down his life for us.
