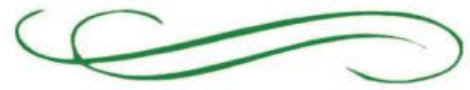



Baptism Preparation Classes
