



Church Windows - Part 7 by Deacon Greg

The Window Committee (the Committee) met on the following dates: 22 May 2024, 29 May 2024, 5 June 2024, 12 June 2024, 20 June 2024, and 11 July 2024. During the July meeting, the Committee finalized recommendations for the windows theme and scenes as well as guiding principles, concepts, and considerations for the artistic design phase of the windows project. The Committee provided the recommendations to Fr. Tim for consideration and review. On 31 July, the parish submitted the windows theme and scene proposal document to Fr. Zach Brown for presentation to Bishop Thomas for his consideration and approval. Fr. Brown assists the diocese and Bishop with church related arts and environment issues. When we receive the Bishop's decision on our windows theme and scene proposal request, we may then move forward with the actual art design of each window scene and patterns. The Bishop must also approve the art design for each window before Window Creations may begin the production of each window.

The proposed windows theme and scenes are based on Matthew 25:31-46. The reasons for choosing the theme and scenes are:

- The theme is scriptural. We are All Saints Parish. In Matthew 25, Jesus sets before the Church the pathway to heaven, the criteria for being judged worthy for entrance to everlasting life.
- The theme is timeless, always relevant, and not identified with one specific saint, culture, or period of time. It reflects the universal call to holiness and leads to the eternal.
- The theme is straightforward, with something to encourage and inspire everyone.

The window scenes include the final judgement and the Corporal Works of Mercy.

- 1. Judgement Jesus separating the sheep from the goats
- 2. Feed the hungry
- 3. Give drink to the thirsty
- 4. Welcome the stranger
- 5. Clothe the naked
- 6. Visit the sick
- 7. Visit the imprisoned
- 8. Bury the dead

We proposed the center window behind the organ be the image of a welcoming Jesus with a scene of Jesus and the children. The Sacred Heart of Jesus and Immaculate Heart of Mary windows in the church sanctuary will be updated on Art Glass. The remaining windows will have a pattern design.

In a future article we will share with you the recommended artistic design guiding principles, concepts, and considerations.




