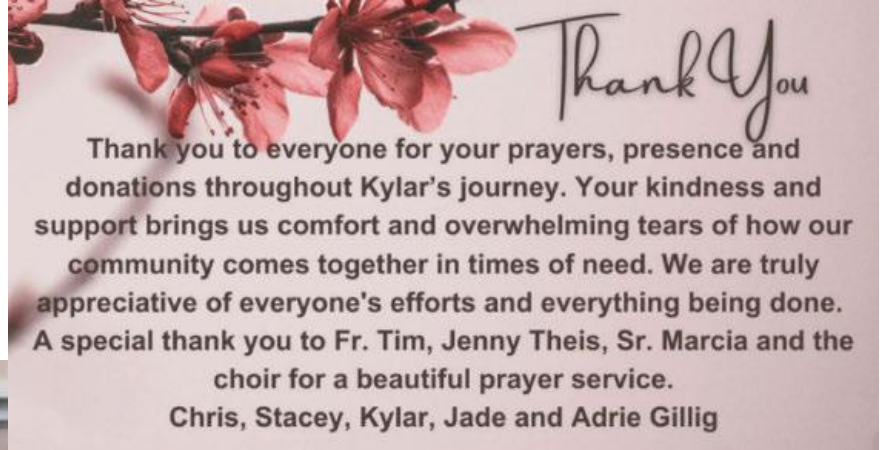

## Pastoral Council Meeting

June 18, 2024

Start: 7:15pm End: 8:45pm

**Attendance:** Lucas Brickner, Allen Reinhart, Margaret Steyer, John Gabel, Brad Zoeller, Bob Swartzmiller, Dan Borer, Sr. Marcia, Deacon Greg.

Deacon Greg started the meeting off with an opening prayer.

**Church Windows:** Sister Marcia informed the Council that the Window Committee (the Committee) has met several different times to begin discussing designs, themes, and concepts for the windows. At their last meeting, the Committee discussed several themes and concepts for the windows. One of their favorite concepts so far is the Corporal Works of Mercy. The Committee developed some concepts and considerations for the artistic design to be used regardless of the chosen theme or scene concept. These guiding principles want the design to be inspirational and educational, simple, allow plenty of light to shine through, include people of all walks of life, ages, skin color and gender since we are a place for everyone, reflect our rural heritage and have an artistic design that is contemporary, but not modern, yet in line with the current Sacred Heart of Jesus and Immaculate Heart of Mary windows. Fr. Tim must review and approve the final recommended theme and scene concept then submit them to Bishop Thomas for his approval before we can proceed with the art design for each window.

Sr. Marcia and Deacon Greg showed pictures of the Sorrowful Mother Shrine windows recently replaced with Art Glass by Window Creations. The pictures show the Art Glass windows still look like stained glass but allow for more light to come through and for more detailed images to be portrayed on the windows. The Committee will meet again to continue working toward a final recommendation.

**Survey:** Deacon Greg went over the results of the survey as they had recategorized some of the responses as of our recommendation from the last meeting. The Council discussed a few take aways from the survey which included suggestions to adjust the slide show during mass to make it easier to find the scripture readings and follow along and to shorten the announcements before mass but still be welcoming and informative. We talked a bit about when and what the parish assembly will look like and how the survey will play into that. Deacon Greg said Father Tim will review the survey results with the parish leadership team upon his return then decide on when and how to publish the results to the parish.

**Business Manager:** Deacon Greg provided an update to the Council. The application period closed on June 18. There were thirteen applicants with five continuing with the interview process. He has begun reviewing their information and completing phone reviews. In-person interviews are scheduled. The plan is to present at least two candidates for a final interview with Father Tim upon his return with an offer and acceptance made on or before July 15.

Sister Marcia led us in a closing prayer.

Every three years an on-site audit is conducted, when not only all necessary documentation is dutifully submitted, but in addition, Pastoral Center, parish and diocesan school employees are interviewed concerning practices and protocols related to creating and maintaining a safe environment for our children and youth.

The last 3-year audit was conducted in October of 2021. The next on-site audit will be conducted in September of 2024.

The Diocese of Toledo remains committed to ensuring the protection of children and providing a safe environment for all young people. If you have any knowledge of abuse that has been committed by a cleric or by any personnel of the Catholic Church, you are urged to report the abuse to your local police department, Children Services, and the Diocesan Victim Assistance Coordinator at (419) 214-4880; or by mail at 1933 Spielbusch Avenue; Toledo, Ohio 43604.

## Gospel Meditation

### Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

The famous Russian novelist Fyodor Dostoyevsky said, “Love in action is a harsh and dreadful thing.” In the Gospel reading this week, Jesus does something harsh and dreadful — he watches his own disciples abandon him. What could possibly be loving about that?

Well, we notice the context is Jesus’ teaching about eating and drinking his body and blood. His followers hear this and say, “**This teaching is difficult; who can accept it?**” (John 6:60). We shouldn’t imagine we’d do anything different, because not even the ones who stay, like Peter, seem to understand what Jesus is saying. Then we hear this devastating line, “**Because of this many of his disciples turned back and no longer went about with him**” (John 6:66). Besides the night of the Last Supper, only now do Jesus’ disciples abandon him. And, painfully, Jesus just lets them go.

The best way to make sense out of this is love. Jesus is God’s love in action. He wants to become one with those whom He loves. He wants to love them as His own body. Yes, the oneness manifested in the Eucharist sounds harsh and dreadful because it is rooted in love which is willing to risk abandonment and separation to attain its goal: to be one body with the beloved. It is both terrifying and wonderful that Jesus will risk losing us in order to be one with us. Our response? Lord, we cannot grasp a love so great, but please help us never to abandon it, either.
