





## Diocese of Toledo Announces Credible Allegation Of Sexual Abuse of a Minor Against Deceased Monsignor Michael J. Doyle

The Diocese of Toledo is announcing the credible allegation, dating back over 65 years, of sexual abuse of a minor against deceased priest Monsignor Michael J. Doyle.


Monsignor Doyle served as an active priest of the Diocese from 1925-1977 when he was granted Senior Status (retired) and later died in 1987. Consistent with Diocesan policy initiated in 2019 concerning allegations made after a priest's death, this allegation (dating back over 65 years) was referred to the independent Diocesan Review Board. That Board is comprised of professionals that include civil officials, law enforcement, education, clinical and child/adolescent psychological treatment and child protective services. Based on available information, the Review Board made the recommendation that Monsignor Doyle's name be added to the Clergy Status Report. Bishop Daniel Thomas accepted that recommendation. This is the second allegation made against Monsignor Doyle, which like the first, also came only long after his death. The first allegation went through the independent Review Board process where all available information was carefully examined in 2020. At that time Bishop Thomas had insisted upon the additional review even of allegations made against deceased priests who had died prior to an allegation being reported. The Review Board determined that there was not enough information to substantiate that first allegation and Bishop Thomas accepted that recommendation.

As is our policy, Monsignor Doyle's name has been added to the <u>Clergy Status Report</u> (<a href="https://toledodiocese.org/clergy-status">https://toledodiocese.org/clergy-status</a>) on the diocesan website, parishioners at the parishes in which he served were notified this weekend, and announcements will be placed in those parish bulletins. In 2002 an addition to the Diocesan Pastoral Center building was named Monsignor Doyle Hall and, due to the above determination, the diocese has removed his name from the building. The Diocese is committed to transparency and to the healing process of individuals who report harm and will continue to respect the confidentiality and dignity of those who elect to come forward, whenever they make that decision.

The Diocese of Toledo remains vigilant in ensuring the protection of children and providing a safe environment for all young people, as well as ensuring the dignity and integrity of the priesthood. The Diocese of Toledo asks for your continued prayers for all those involved.

Any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor by a priest, deacon, staff member or volunteer affiliated with the Diocese of Toledo should first be reported to local law enforcement where the abuse is alleged to have occurred. Please also report any such allegation to the Diocesan Victim Assistance Coordinator at 419-214-4880.

## Gospel Meditation Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

Once at an evening Mass as a poor college student, the collection basket was fast approaching, and I only had a tendollar bill. I was planning on using that to buy my favorite Chipotle burrito that night for dinner. Should I keep the money? Who would know if I did? If I gave it away, what would I eat? Would I be okay? I kissed my future burrito goodbye, dropped the money in the basket, and winced. But strangely, the rest of the Mass I felt more engaged than usual. I had skin in the game. I left the Mass excited to see how God would take care of me. And he did, in amazing ways.

When the poor widow places two copper coins in the temple treasury, Jesus doesn't pity her. He praises her. He blesses her. He brags about her. He celebrates her as the temple's largest benefactor. Her giving is an act of radical, concrete trust in God. It is as if she is entering a new level of giving that excites Jesus, because she contributes not out of her abundance, but she gives "everything she had."

What a challenge this is to each one of us! How easy it is to ignore this! But imagine the eruption of the energy of faith, hope, and love that would be unlocked if our financial sacrifices to the Church actually tapped into daily bread and not only our disposable income. I challenge us to try this in some way this coming week and see what happens in our hearts. Even if it costs us a burrito.
