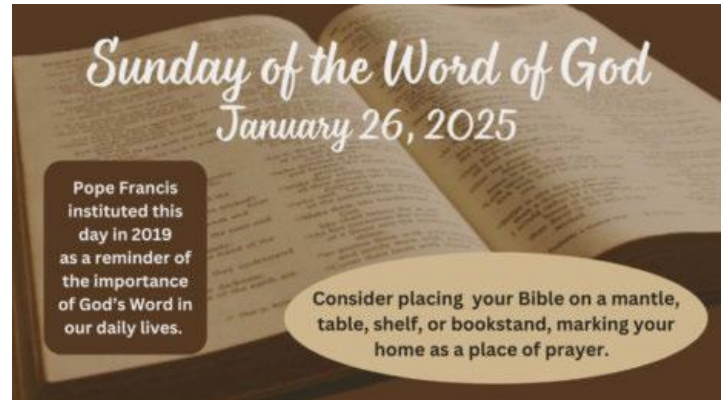

## Pastoral Council Meeting

17 December 2024, Start: 7:30pm End: 8:45 PM

**Attendance** – Present: Allen Reinhart, Alicia Swartzmiller, Tim Kimmet, Fr. Tim and Deacon Greg (ex officio). Not able to attend: None

The meeting began with a prayer.

### Review and discussion of Nominations and nomination/discernment process

- Reviewed, summarized, and discussed the December 10 candidate discernment meeting in which of the 34 names submitted by parish nomination, 10 persons were interested in discerning the 6 open positions.
- Reviewed and discussed each interested candidate's desire to continue or not continue with the process and considered all candidate wishing to continue with the selection process.
- This discernment process has led to the invitation of Luke Elchert, Karen Fritsch, Sr. Carol Inkrott, John Kidd, Gary Schalk and Tom Wise as new Council members. All candidates have accepted the invitation.
- Joyce Meyer was also discerned as a new Council member. She expressed interest through the Stewardship Survey.
- Jayden Nye and Macy Schubach, members of the Youth Board, expressed interest and were recommended as Council Members.
- Existing Council members are Alicia Swartzmiller, Tim Kimmet and Allen Reinhart. With these existing members and the nine new members, the Council now has twelve members.
- Fr. Tim and Deacon Greg serve as Ex Officio members of the Council.

### Council Structure

- Fr. Tim explained the need to have one or two members serve as facilitators (coordinators, organizing secretary or chairperson) to coordinate the preparation of the meeting agenda, sending reminder emails and facilitating each meeting. To that end, Council decided to ask Sr. Carol and John Kidd to serve jointly in this role. Deacon Greg will contact and discuss with both.
- Deacon Greg will serve as the recording secretary. He will take minutes at each meeting, work with Fr. Tim to approve the minutes and work with Regina to publish the minutes in the bulletin.
- Council recommended establishing a core team to plan meetings for the year and perform other organizational functions. The core team consists of Fr. Tim, Deacon Greg, Alicia Swartzmiller, and the Council Facilitator(s). The first core team meeting is set for January 14.

### February 18 Council Meeting

- Andrew Reinhart from the Diocesan Office will be with the Council to discuss the diocesan healthy parish document.

**Next meeting** - Tuesday, January 21, 2025, at 7:15PM in the Emmaus Room. The focus of the meeting is the diocesan healthy parish document.

The meeting ended with a closing prayer.

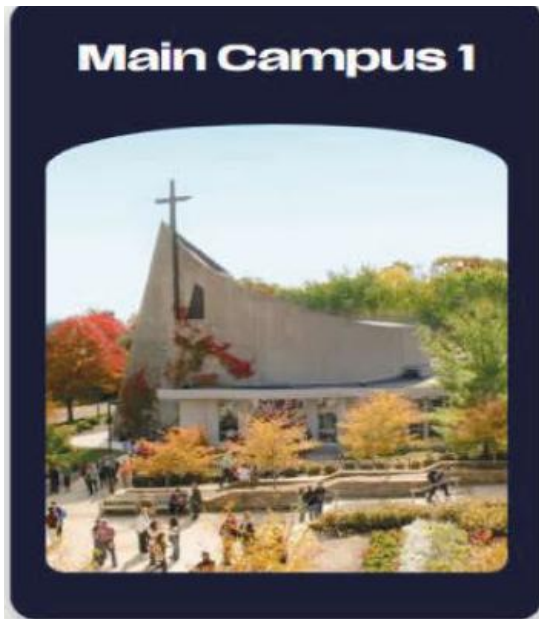

## Gospel Meditation

### Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

A young couple in my parish told me they were expecting their second child, a baby boy. I knew that their five-year old only child Emma had been desperately wanting to be a big sister for years, so I said, "Emma must have been so happy when you told her the news." "Actually," they said, "she burst into tears. She wanted a baby *sister!*" How often in life God wonderfully fulfills our desires and we are sad because we don't approve of the way he does it. We want to control the gift and the delivery method.

The same thing occurs in the Gospel this week when Jesus announces in his hometown that the promise of an Anointed One bringing glad tidings to the poor is **"fulfilled in your hearing" (Luke 4:21)**. After a moment of elation, his fellow townsfolk realize *this man* is the way God is fulfilling his promises, and they erupt into a violent outburst. So Jesus departs. How sad for them.

Every single Sunday at Mass, including this one, some version of this happens to many of us. God's word announces the fulfillment of God's promises in Christ, and we easily overlook or disdain it. His way is almost never according to our narrow expectations. What's required of us is to set these aside, and to embrace a new openness to God's gifts, no matter how he wishes to give them. God is fulfilling his promises the way He likes — why be sad?


