





Church Windows - Part 10

Windows design update

It's been a while since we provided you with an update. We apologize for the delay.

As a reminder, we're replacing the current windows with energy efficient triple pain windows that include art glass. The chosen scenes are printed on the art glass. The Immaculate Heart of Mary and Sacred Heart of Jesus windows in the sanctuary will be updated with minor changes. The scenes for the windows in the body of the church include the final judgement and the Corporal Works of Mercy.

- 1. Judgement Jesus separating the sheep from the goats
- 2. Feed the hungry
- 3. Give drink to the thirsty
- 4. Welcome the stranger
- 5. Clothe the naked
- 6. Visit the sick
- 7. Visit the imprisoned
- 8. Bury the dead

Window Creations is colorizing the art design for each window. They will have the designs to us on or before Tuesday, February 11. We'll use the drawings in the request for approval package we present to Bishop Thomas during our meeting with him on Friday, February 21. The Bishop must approve the drawings before Window Creations can begin the window manufacturing process. We are hopeful to gain the Bishop's approval during our meeting. If he has some suggested changes, we'll work with him and Window Creations to make the required changes.

Once we receive the Bishop's approval, we plan to share the window scenes with you. We plan to have multiple dates and times for you to see the approved windows and hear about the background story for each window. We'll give you more information about the meetings once we finalize the plans.

Estimated Window Production and Installation Schedule

Window Creations gave us the following estimated schedule. While this schedule may change, we want you to have a general idea of how we think the process will play out. We hope this helps. We and they will work to minimize the impact on weddings and weekend Masses.

- The frames and (clear exterior) glass are ready to be installed into the three windows
 that have already been removed. We are just waiting on the right weather conditions to
 install, probably Spring at this point.
- The remainder of the frames will be fabricated over the Winter.
- Designs for the art glass should be finalized in March.
- Installation of the remaining frames and glass will likely be the Summer/Fall of 2025



Gospel Meditation Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

My parents' garage is full of old junk that no longer serves any purpose in my life. As a 46-year-old man, I admit that's pretty lame. Either due to my sentimentality or laziness (or both, probably), I just couldn't get myself to throw things away. But a few days ago, by a grace of God, I thought: "I'll hire my nephew Ryan to throw a bunch of my stuff away — he couldn't care less about my junk!" And you know what? It worked. In one day, Ryan chucked the majority of his uncle's useless stuff. I feel so free, ready for a new junk-free chapter in my life.

This kind of thing happens in this Sunday's Gospel. Peter's net is full of useless junk. Luke says he and the others are cleaning their nets after catching no fish. Imagine them dejectedly and impatiently removing a nasty assortment of seaweed, sticks and muck. The Lord teaches and calls them once their nets are cleared out. So it goes with us. Spiritual life begins by removing that which is useless and merely taking up space in our hearts, minds and lives. Then Jesus teaches and acts in a marvelous way in our lives, too.

So what's junking up your net? What habits, attachments, possessions, preoccupations? If, like me, you struggle to clean your nets by yourself, ask the Lord to send you someone like my nephew to be your "Peter" and help you clean it out. It is well worth it. Once Peter's net is clean, he is free to make a wonderful catch.




