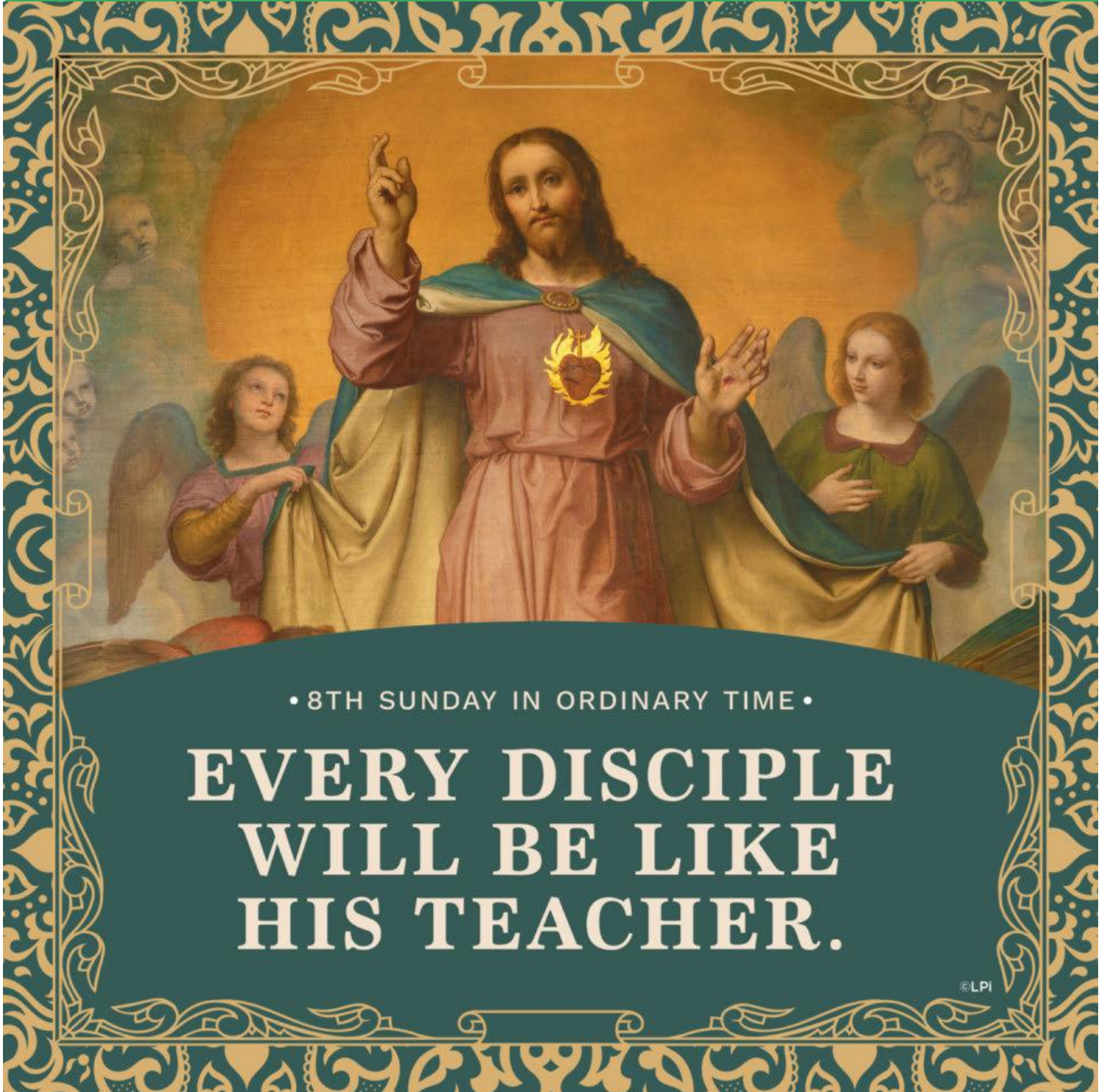





## Blessing of the Lenten Place of Prayer in Your Home

*From Ash Wednesday to Easter,  
a place in the home is set aside for prayer.  
The family's Bible is placed there  
with a crucifix or cross and a candle,  
which is lighted when all have gathered.*

*Sign of the Cross*

**Leader:** The Lord calls us to days of penance and mercy.  
Blessed be the name of the Lord.

**All: Now and forever.**

**Leader:** Remember that we are but dust and ashes, yet by God's grace we have died in Baptism and have put on the Lord Jesus Christ. Each year we keep these Forty Days with prayer and penance and the practice of charity so that we may come to the Easter festival ready to renew once more the life-giving commitment of our Baptism. Through this Lent we shall gather here to read the Scriptures and ponder them and to intercede with God for our needs and for the needs of the Church and the world.

**Optional Reading from Scripture: Isaiah 58:5-10**

### Prayers of Intercession

*After a time of silence, all offer prayers of intercession for our world,  
the Church, for those in the OCIA process, and for their family.*

**Leader:** Let us kneel and ask God's blessing on us and on this holy season. Merciful God, you called us forth from the dust of the earth; you claimed us for Christ in the waters of Baptism. Look upon us as we enter these 40 days bearing the marks of ashes, and bless our journey through the desert of Lent to the font of rebirth. May our fasting be hunger for justice; our alms, a making of peace, our prayer, the chant of humble and grateful hearts. All that we do and pray is in the name of Jesus, for in his Cross you proclaim your love forever and ever.

*Each person then kisses the Crucifix. All stand*

**Leader:** All through these days let us be quiet and prayerful, pondering the mysteries told in the Scriptures. In the Cross, we have been claimed for Christ. In Christ, we make the prayer that fills these days of mercy.

**Leader:** Let us bless the Lord.

**All: Thanks be to God.**

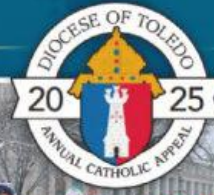

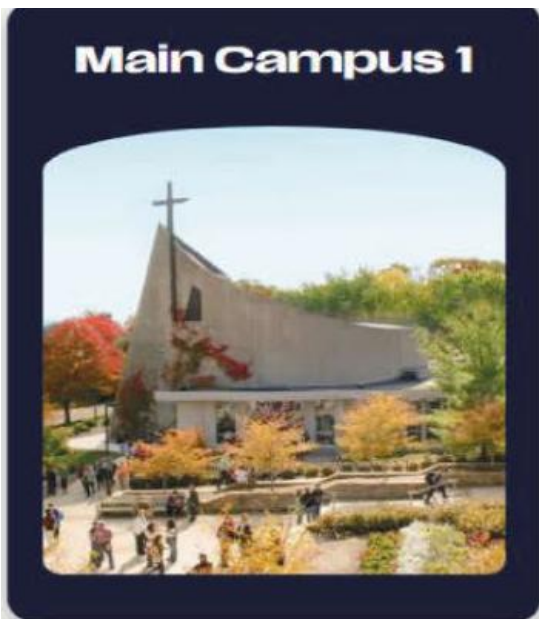

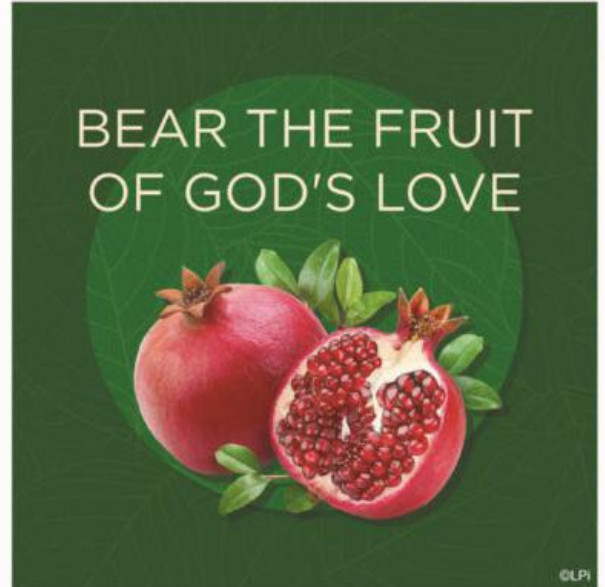

## Gospel Meditation

### Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

One of the things that older pastors and younger priests occasionally quarrel about is the proper balance between work and prayer. I know one pastor who complains that his younger associate ignores the people and the parish because he wants to spend more time in prayer. And the young priest complains that the pastor gives him too much work to do and no time to pray. The Lord's words this Sunday speak into this tension with an image that can help us find a proper balance between life and prayer.


Jesus says, **"For every tree is known by its fruit. For people do not pick figs from thorn bushes, nor do they gather grapes from brambles"** (Luke 6:44). When we are deeply rooted and cultivating our relationship with Jesus, we are going to bear the fruit of that love in our lives. No fruit, no good prayer. How do we know that we are praying well? We are experiencing concrete fruits of love for others in our lives.

Someone who prays well will, sooner or later, burst forth the "figs" and "grapes" of acts of love. But without concrete commitment to deeds of selfless service to others, our prayer time is as useless as thorn bushes and brambles. Let's recommit ourselves to be men and women of prayer and service. And hopefully the pastors will help their associates to pray *and* serve fruitfully...with minimal quarreling.


