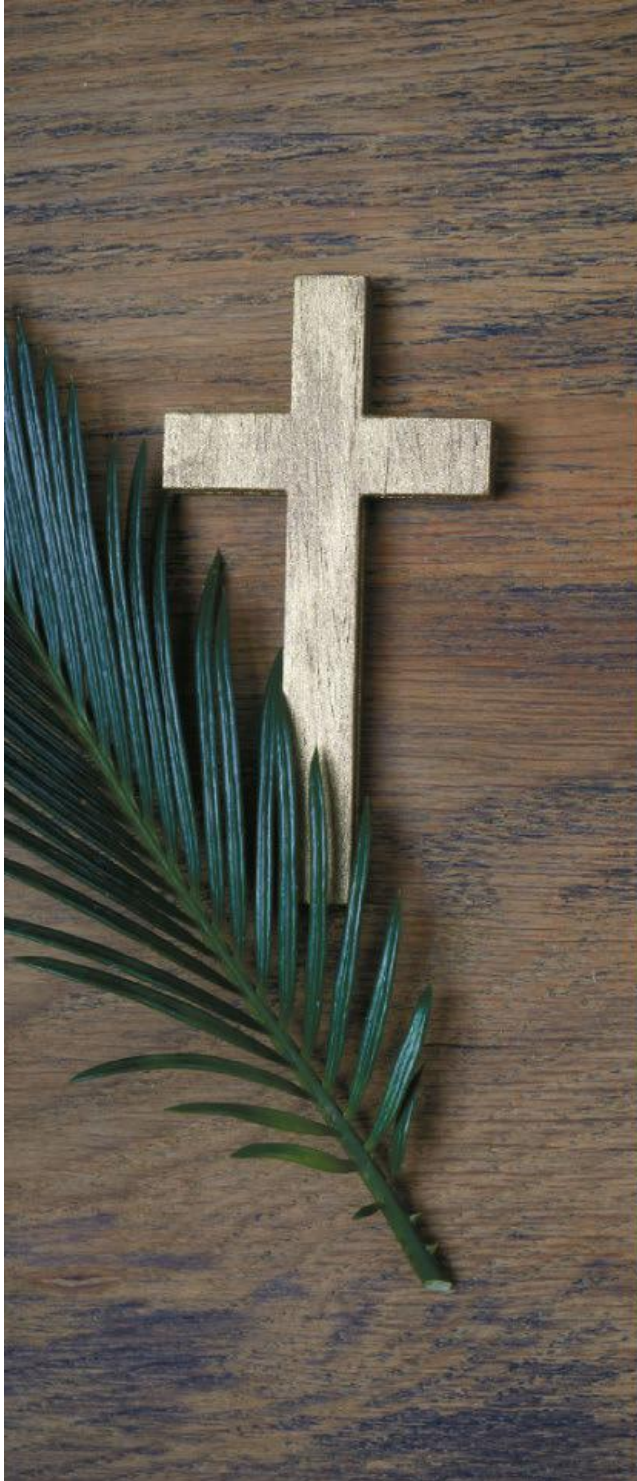

Church Windows – Part 11



We have the Bishop’s Approval

Bishop Thomas approved the colorized window scenes during our meeting with him on Friday, February 21. The scenes depict the Last Judgment and the Corporal Works of Mercy. Bishop Thomas was so gracious to us and was (and is) so excited about our windows theme and the artistic designs. He used words like beautiful, amazing, stunning and genius to describe the robust colors, imagery and artistic design used for each window scene.

The Window Committee continues to meet to finalize details in the artistic designs. Bishop Thomas has given us permission to work through those changes and revisions with Fr. Zach Brown, one of his representatives on church environment. Bishop Thomas was very complementary of the wisdom and work of our Committee, and he trusts us to move forward with Fr. Zach so that details can be finalized, and installation of the new windows will not be delayed.

The Windows Committee is working to determine how best to share the approved window designs with our parishioners. We will share more about this in the coming weeks.

Exterior window work

Window Creations plans to begin working on the exterior parts of the windows sometime in late March. They need to prepare the exterior wood framing and work on other preparations needed to begin installation sometime in late August or early September.

Existing windowpanes with names

The Committee plans to auction off the portion of the stained-glass windows that have family names. This includes the panes with names being replaced by the new art glass scene windows. Please keep in mind the current stained glass is very brittle and fragile. We will do our best to preserve the stained glass with names, but we make no promises. Once the glass is removed and after the new windows are installed, we will announce plans for auctioning the stained glass with names.

Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

One of the most fascinating moments in American history is when George Washington could have become the king of the newly liberated United States and didn't. At the height of his power and fame, on Dec. 23, 1783, he resigned his commission as Commander-in-Chief, and went home. The astonished King of England remarked that in doing so, Washington was "the greatest man in the world." Greatness is often defined by what we could do but don't. Greatness is measured by the temptations we overcome.

Jesus' greatness is revealed in his victory over temptations, too. The three offered him by the devil contain, we might say, all potential possible temptations: food, power and fame. They correspond to the triple human needs of body, soul and spirit. In overcoming these three, he says "no" in essence to every and even the greatest temptation. We see that every desire of his humanity — body, soul and spirit — is perfectly united to God, to love. This is a power available to each member of his body. It is the path to true greatness. How can we, who so easily fall into even small temptations, find the power to overcome large ones? By entering into the great dynamics of Jesus' temptations.

Lenten challenge: This first week of Lent, list some concrete ways you can overcome temptations that correspond with your desires. For example, you may give up snacks between meals, choose not to participate in an activity of which you are an expert, and decide to reduce social media posting by 50%. It may not seem like much, but by saying "no" to the tyranny of food, power, and fame (in this example), you'll discover true greatness.
