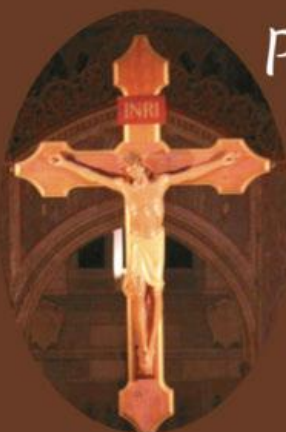

Pastoral Council Meeting 18 March 2025, Start: 7:15pm End: 9:10 PM

Attendance – Pastoral Council members present: Allen Reinhart, Alicia Swartzmiller, Tim Kimmet, Karen Fritsch, John Kidd, Sr. Carol Inkrott, Gary Schalk, Tom Wise, Luke Elchert, Joyce Meyer, and ex officio members Fr. Tim and Deacon Greg. Not able to attend: Alicia Swartzmiller, Jayden Nye and Macy Schubach (both on senior class trip)

Fr. Tim introduced each member of the Pastoral Council Leadership Team. The Leadership team includes: Co-Coordinators Sr. Carol Inkrott and John Kidd, Organizing Secretary Alicia Swartzmiller and Ex Officio members Fr. Tim and Deacon Greg. The Leadership team meets prior to the Pastoral Council meetings to organize and set the agenda for each meeting.

The Council participated in an opening prayer.

Sr. Carol led the Council in some “ice breaker” exercises to help the Council Members to get to know each other.

Sr. Carol introduced and explained synodality and the synodality process. The Holy Father and world Synod on Synodality call us to synodality and be one as the people of God. Because of this, the Council plans to use the synodality process to help discern and listen to the voice of the Holy Spirit as the Council does its work to help lead the parish. This work, which branches from the Synod on Synodality, includes promoting a new style of being church, a new style of leadership, being a more welcoming and inclusive church, the centrality of the Liturgy and a new way of including all people in full and equal participation in the life of the Church. The synodality process helps ensure that all have an equal right to participate and all have equal dignity which starts with our Baptism. The process provides time for each member to carefully speak and listen as well as time for silence and prayer. The synodality process is a time for, “conversation in the Spirit.”

The Council participated in several exercises using the synodality process. The meeting ended with a closing prayer.
