## **Pastoral Council Meeting**

**21-Oct-2025**, Start: 7:15pm End: 9:00 PM

**Attendance** – Pastoral Council members present: Karen Fritsch, Sr. Carol Inkrott, John Kidd, Joyce Meyer, Jayden Nye, Alicia Swartzmiller, Tom Wise, Luke Elchert, Tim Kimmet, Allen Reinhart, Gary Schalk and ex officio members Fr. Tim and Deacon Greg. Not able to attend: All Present.

John Kidd served as the facilitator and led us in the prayer to the Holy Spirit that was prayed at the Second Vatican Council, then invited all to participate in a short ice breaker.

The council studied the second pillar of the Second Vatican Council and of Pope Francis: Responsibility. Each baptized person has a responsibility to engage alongside the pastor in the work of the parish and in the mission of Jesus. As the Council members participated in the conversation in the Spirit, they learned that each of them was already doing that in a wide variety of ways. They also learned that they had all learned service from their parents either by actual training or by their parents' example and that ministry later in life came with a stronger sense of commitment. They acknowledged that serving causes a person to feel good; but that to be real Christian service, it needs to be done for Jesus.

Questions for the parish to ponder:

1. As a parent/grandparent what am I doing to help my children/grandchildren become good Christian servants?
2. What motivates me to be of service to the parish and in the world—Feeling good? Habit? Helping with the mission of Jesus?

Father Tim gave a summary report including:

- The annual offertory enhancement program through OSV intended to reinforce the importance of financial stewardship of the parish.
- The summer giving campaign exceeded the goal of \$250,000. Fr. Tim shared his gratitude for the generosity of the parishioners as shown in this campaign, the Living Christ Campaign, the Annual Catholic Appeal, the weekly collection, and prior capital campaigns.
- Reminder about the windows blessings Mass at the November 16 10 AM Mass celebrated by Bishop Thomas.
- Update on the parish hall renovations and water quality issues.
- A two-night Parish Mission on March 8 & 9, with Paul Fahey and Monica Pope, focusing on the social teachings of the Church and the Corporal Works of Mercy.

The meeting ended with the "How Can I Pray For You" group prayer exercise.
