Are you moving? Are you leaving us? I've been asked these questions a lot over the past few months. The answer to both questions is yes.

Carol and I have four sons and eighteen grandchildren. Three of our four sons and their families (including sixteen of our grandchildren) live just south of Dayton (Springboro) and just north of the I75/I275 connection north of Cincinnati. While we love living in this part of Seneca County, we feel the need to be closer to our family. We'll be about 15-25 minutes from them rather than three hours or so. We finally found a house in Monroe in Butler County. If all goes well, we close the purchase of the house in the first week of February and move shortly after that. After we move, I will remain a deacon of the Diocese of Toledo but will be released to serve in the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. At this point, I plan on being here to assist every other weekend through Lent and be part of our Easter Triduum liturgies. The Easter Triduum liturgies are my last regular, scheduled liturgies as deacon at All Saints. My mom lives here in New Riegel, and both of our extended families live in this area. So, we will be back to visit fairly frequently. I hope to assist at Mass from time to time. As we get closer to May, we will have time to share in gratitude for the life of faith we've experienced together. *Deacon Greg*



Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

It's common to hear belief in Jesus and the Church mocked as blind faith and credulity. But in reality, it is deeply human and rational. Think about it: we rely on the testimony of others constantly. I trust chemists who certify the safety of toothpaste and cleaning products. I trust engineers when I use a microwave or drive over a bridge. Why? Because they have studied and seen what I have not, and their testimony proves itself in daily life. That kind of trust is not irrational; it is how human knowledge works.

In today's Gospel, John the Baptist declares: **"Now I have seen and testified that he is the Son of God" (John 1:34).** That is the language of an eyewitness. It invites us into a very human act: trusting someone who has directly encountered something — or Someone — we have not yet fully seen ourselves.

The Church's faith is built on this kind of reliable sight-based testimony. The Apostles did not make abstract claims. They saw, followed, suffered for, and proclaimed Jesus Christ. Over centuries, their witness — carried in Scripture, in the lives of the saints, and in the sacramental life of the Church — has proven dependable. We come to know its truth by assenting to it, by living and studying it, praying with it, trusting it.

Faith in Christ is not a childish leap into the dark. It is a step into the light of testimony that proves itself over time.
