





Parents and Guardians,

All Saints is aware of the efforts of LifeWise Academy and the interest of some, to bring their program to influence the youth of our community. After reviewing available information about this program, we have learned that it conflicts with certain doctrinal beliefs of the Catholic Church as well as Catholic Social teaching and our approach to the study and understanding of sacred scripture.

As partners in faith formation of our children, we want to share some important guidance regarding religious education opportunities available to families this school year. Our parish remains committed to providing comprehensive, age-appropriate, and theologically sound religious education programing. Our program is intentionally designed to align with our parish mission, sacramental preparation, and the broader life of the Church community and conforms to Diocesan syllabus requirements. Participation in parish based religious education also helps with fostering unity among our families and ensures consistent formation rooted in our shared values and traditions.

While we respect the intentions of all who seek to offer faith-based instruction to children, we strongly encourage our catholic families to prioritize participation in our parish education programs rather than outside programs that take place during the school day. Parish-based formation allows children to grow in faith alongside their peers, clergy and catechists who are directly connected and accountable to our parish community.

We believe that keeping religious education within the parish setting best supports our children's spiritual development, reinforces family involvement and strengthens our faith community as a whole. We see this lived out in the continued engagement of our high school and college aged students in parish ministries and activities.

We are grateful for your continued commitment to your child's faith journey.



Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

A few years into my priesthood, I hit a wall. I had taken on too many commitments: Masses, meetings, ministries, projects. I couldn't keep up. I was double-booking, forgetting things, running late, and letting people down. My boss at the time, a wise priest, and our shared secretary, noticed. For my birthday, the two gave me a stack of 100 flashcards, each with one word printed in a different language: "NO." It was funny, but also painfully true. If I couldn't say no, my yes was in danger.

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus says, **"Let your 'Yes' mean 'Yes,' and your 'No' mean 'No.' Anything more is from the Evil One"** (**Matthew 5:37**). He's not just giving advice about polite speech. He's showing us something about the freedom of Christian discipleship. The follower of Christ is called to speak clearly, simply, and honestly. There is joy in that kind of freedom.

The Church Fathers often linked this kind of straightforward truthfulness with spiritual maturity. The devil is the father of lies, but Jesus is the Word made flesh. When we hedge, flatter, exaggerate, or avoid, we open space for the shadows to creep in. That little stack of flashcards reminded me that God does not want us enslaved to the expectations of others or to the fear of disappointing them. He wants us to enjoy the peace of saying yes and meaning it, and saying no, and meaning it, too.


Lenten Challenge: Practice one moment of honest, peaceful speech this week. Maybe it's a sincere "yes" to something important, or a humble "no" to something you cannot do. Let it be a quiet step into the freedom Jesus offers.

~Are mandatory for all parents who have not attended a Baptism Class or if it's been 3 years since your last class.

~Classes should be taken prior to birth.

~Available on the Second Sunday of March, June, September and December

Please call the parish office to sign up for class.

Baptisms

~Normally baptisms will be celebrated during Mass.

~Baptisms after Mass will be celebrated on the:

2nd Sundays in January, February, May, July, October, November and the 3rd Sunday of August

Baptisms will not be celebrated during Lent. Please visit our website for online forms or contact the parish office to schedule a date and time or to make other arrangements.

Marriage Preparation

~Contact the priest or deacon at least six months prior to the wedding, and before securing a hall.

~Weddings will not be celebrated during Advent or Lent.
