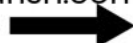

Chapel Memorials In Our Cemeteries

When we let go of our chapel buildings, along with our cherished memories, we held on to the corner stones, bells and steeple crosses, where appropriate, in hopes of erecting simple memorials in each of our Catholic cemeteries. The All Saints Cemetery Board met recently and is beginning to plan for what those memorials might look like and where they might be placed in each of our cemeteries. According to diocesan leadership the designs must be modest, reflecting the dignity of the consecrated grounds. They memorialize the worshiping faith of our ancestors and are an expression of our Catholic faith still alive today. We plan for these simple memorials to be similar in proportion and expense and hope that each memorial might bare an image of the chapel building that stood near to these sacred grounds. Simple designs are being considered and local contractors with experience in concrete, brick and stone will be invited to contribute in experience and effort.

The first step for us now, is to consider the best placement for each of the memorials. The members of the Cemetery Board will visit each of the cemeteries and look together for the best site. They will be listening to ideas and concerns of all our members. In some cases there may seem to be an obvious site, and yet, as in all things, not everybody see's things the same. We will seek consensus and move forward carefully. If you have an idea about the placement of these simple memorials at St. Andrew, St Patrick, St Nicholas and St Peter Cemeteries, you can offer your insights at a specially created email address: allsaintscemeteries2026@gmail.com. The website will be active through Sunday, May 31, 2026, after which all suggestions will be reviewed by the Cemetery Board. We are indebted to the work of the All Saints Cemetery Board which includes: **Rick Brickner, Dustin Humphrey, Doug Brickner, Mike Metzger, Brian Zoeller, Mary Ann Zoeller, Tammy Weinandy, Cindy Brickner, Regina Wagner, Noah Fox and frTim**. They all carry a deep commitment to the care of our cemeteries, and see their ministry as carrying out one of the *Corporal Works of Mercy...Burying the Dead*. They willingly carry forward this unique commitment of guiding the creation of simple chapel memorials on our cemetery grounds. They look forward to hearing from you.

WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS

(Good Shepherd Sunday)



A TRADITION for MOTHERS..

Like St. Monica, sometimes a mother sheds many tears when a son responds to his divine calling. Before St. Augustine returned to the practice of the faith and was ordained a priest his mother shed many tears of intercession. Similarly, many mothers in today's world will make countless sacrifices so that their son can freely respond to whatever calling God has in store for him.

Recognizing this reality a pious tradition has been passed on over the years that pays respect to the role a mother has in a priest's life. When a priest is ordained his hands are anointed with chrism oil by the bishop. After this occurs his hands are cleaned with a white linen towel called a maniturgium. The oil that is used on the hands of the priest is sacred, having been previously consecrated by the bishop.

According to an age-old tradition the mother saves the towel in a safe place until she dies. Then when her body is prepared for the funeral the maniturgium is placed within the hands of the mother.

When she arrives to the gates of heaven she is escorted directly to our Lord. Our Lord says to the woman - "I have given you life, what have you given to me?" She hands him the maniturgium and responds, "I have given you my son as a priest." At this Jesus grants her entry into paradise.

It is a beautiful and consoling tradition that is always a touching ceremony to witness. Many more tears are shed when a young priest presents the towel to his mother, tears of joy instead of sorrow.

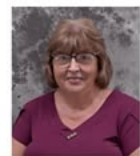

2nd Sundays in January, February, May, July, October, November and the 3rd Sunday of August

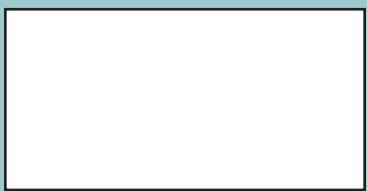
Baptisms will not be celebrated during Lent. Please visit our website for online forms or contact the parish office to schedule a date and time or to make other arrangements.

~Weddings will not be celebrated during Advent or Lent.

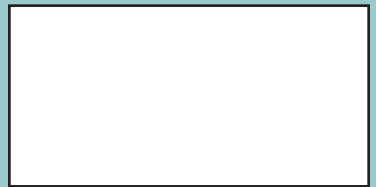

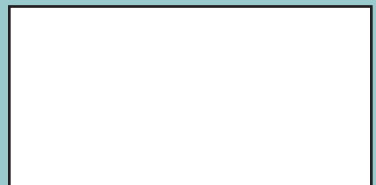
